According to H.R 2281 Section 202(c)(3)(A), your notification must be in writing to our Designated Agent; and, you are required to provide the following information in its entirety to ensure that we can identify and legally remove the infringing content from our servers:

1. A physical or electronic signature of a person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is alleged to be infringed
2. Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed; or, if multiple copyrighted works at a single site are covered by a single notification, a representative list of such works at that site
3. Identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing or to be the subject of infringing activity and that is to be removed or access to which is to be disabled, and information reasonably sufficient to permit us to locate the material
4. Information reasonably sufficient to permit us to contact the complaining party, such as address, telephone number, and (if available) an email address at which the complaining party may be contacted
5. A statement that the complaining party has a good faith belief that the use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law
6. A statement that the information in the notification is accurate and, under the penalties of perjury, that the complaining party is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed

Upon receipt of a legally presented notification, we will promptly remove the items from the allegedly infringing website or web server; and, we will notify the user of record for that website or web server so that they may make a counter notification.
